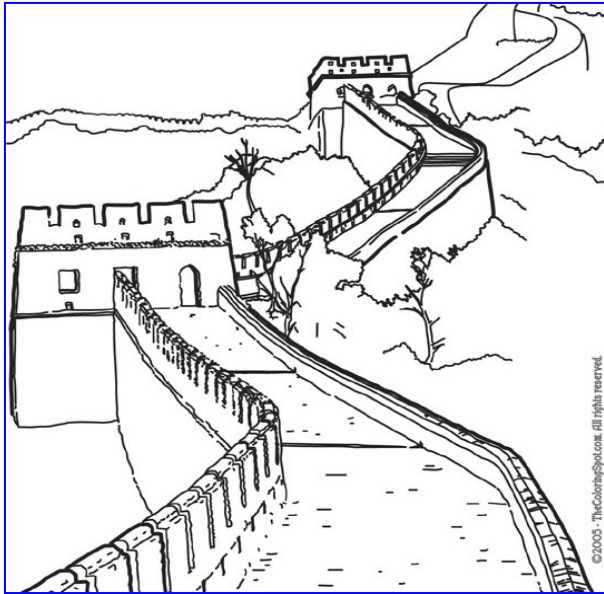

Student Classes at Cutten

Focus: Introduction to Chinese language including greetings, colors, numbers, polite requests and songs.

Students will actively learn both the language (Including basic calligraphy), sing songs, learn traditional Chinese stories and myths, play games and do art projects.

Daily Schedule:

9 a.m. - 11 a.m. Language and cultural instruction (including movement and hands-on activities when appropriate.).

11 a.m. - 12 a.m. Activities with parents taking adult classes including Chinese games and activities.

Student classes are offered by Consultant for Global Programs and Adoption Horizons.

Adult Classes at Winship

Focus: Introduction to Chinese language including travel Chinese. Lessons on Chinese culture (including “do’s and don’ts” and polite greetings.).

Daily Schedule:

9 a.m. - 11 a.m. Language and Culture instruction with emphasis on pronunciation and survival Chinese. Instruction will include basic symbols and writing—but the primary emphasis is speaking and culture.

11 a.m. - 12 noon During the last hour of the Adult classes parents of children taking the classes at Cutten Elementary will have the option of joining their children for instruction and Chinese games and activities.
